

Rules of the Touring Friends Motorcycle Club 01/09/2012

- #1. Positively no alcohol or drugs while riding as a club
- #2. If there is a conflict among members please do not take care of it on the ride. When the ride is over the persons involved will meet with the officers and discuss and resolve the problem.
- #3. You may invite a friend, after three rides they must fill out an application to join. The Motorcycle operator must sign a WAIVER each time they ride!
- #4. All discussion of Touring Friends business will be discussed between members only.
- #5. There will be no downgrading of another person(s) or their motorcycle(s) or property(s). No racial or sexual remarks. Respect the people whom you are riding with and WATCH YOUR LANGUAGE!
- #6. All motorcycles and drivers must be licensed, maintained and inspected
- #7. If a rider breaks down, everyone stays together. A Designated rider(s) will remain with that rider until further instructions and or help is given. The remaining group will proceed following the original route, until a safe area for everyone is reached.
- #8. The Club patch and lettering is expressly owned by the Club. If a member leaves the Club their patch and lettering will be bought back by the Club at the original purchased price. The President will keep a record of all patch/lettering purchases and new members will sign said record agreeing to the buy back. No other use of Design, Resemblances, Facsimiles or Duplication of Club Patch will be permitted in any form Without Prior consent of Board of Officers.
- #9. The Touring Friends will not be responsible for any damage that occurs to any article of clothing with regards to the removal of the Club patch/lettering.
- #10. When you are part of an organized ride sponsored by the Touring Friends Motorcycle Club and you ride in any position directly behind the Leaders. You WILL be expected to participate as a Blocker (if needed). If you do not wish to fulfill this responsibility you should fall behind those who have chosen to do so.
- #11. When on long rides and the only places around to use as a facility/weather break serve alcohol (Bars) and you are wearing Club colors. You may make use of these establishments only if, You do not purchase ANY alcoholic beverages, You DO NOT sit at the bar for any reason or you ONLY go into these places to use the rest rooms.
